### End of Year Awards

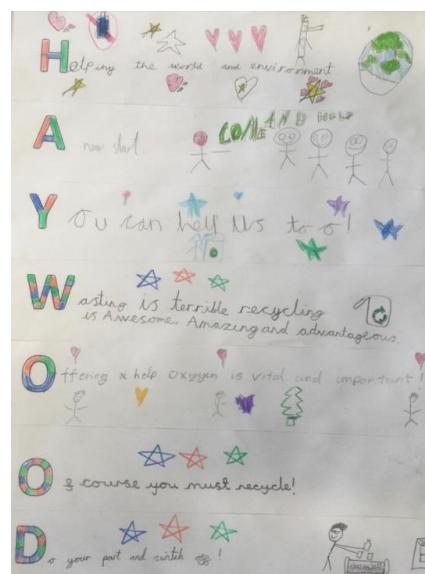
- The Sports Day Cup went to Cabot

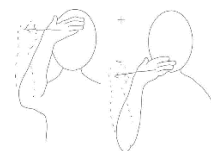
