

Life Cycle UK – Bikeability Level 2 Parental Consent Form

We are delighted to be able to offer our pupils Bikeability level 2, on-road cycle training. The course is funded by North Somerset Council and the Department for Transport and delivered by Life Cycle UK. Places are limited and will be allocated on a **first come first served** basis. Your child will need a roadworthy bicycle to take part. After an initial assessment of their riding skills on the first session, they will be riding on-road, with qualified instructors and **must** be able to cycle already, it is **not** a beginners course. **For children in Year 6 this course is offered to children who did NOT take part in Bikeability when they were in Year 5.**

The course dates are:

Group 1 – 29 June & 30 June (Year 6 and Year 5)

Group 2 – 6 July & 19 July (Year 5 only)

Group 3 – 13 July & 14 July (Year 5 only)

Your child will find out which group they are in nearer the time.

Please make sure your child comes to school with:

- Roadworthy bike – See safety check details overleaf.
- Helmet
- Weather appropriate clothing (raincoat, gloves, sunscreen etc.)
- Water bottle
- Lock - Bikes are to be locked in the bike shed on arrival at school.

What to do now:

- Keep this page for your information.
- Complete and return the following page to school by: **Friday 19 May**
- **Check your child's bike in advance** and fix any problems.

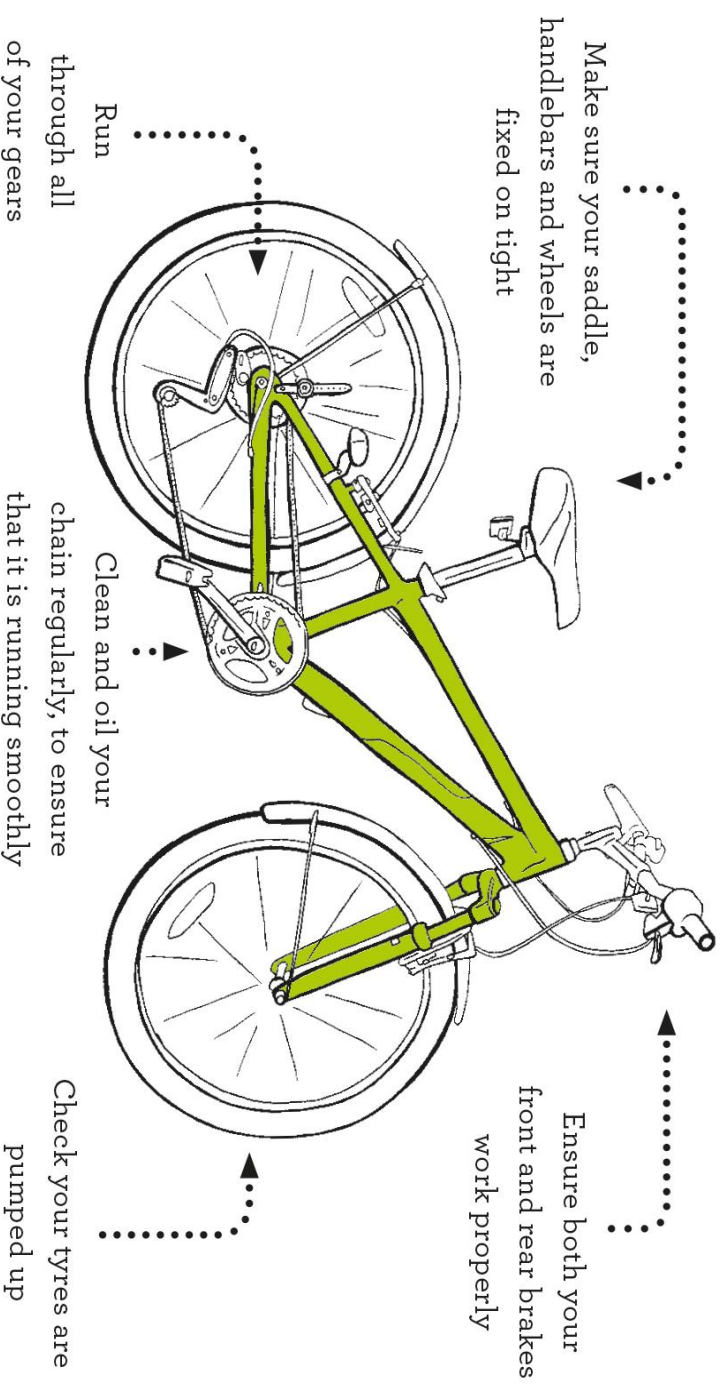
