I am writing to inform you of a wonderful new play provocation we are launching called Boromi. Boromi is a home play initiative which runs like a play library, allowing children to take home carefully selected learning resources, games and toys which they can then share with their families.

The purpose of this initiative is to extend learning beyond the classroom and support children's development through play in a familiar home environment.

Through borrowing items from the play library, your child will have the opportunity to:

- Build confidence and independence
- Develop language and communication skills
- Strengthen problem-solving and creativity
- Share learning experiences with family members

Each term, your child will be able to choose up to 2 play bags to bring home and share with their family. We kindly ask that:

- Items are looked after with care
- All pieces are returned together
- The item is brought back on the agreed return day.

Bags will go home with your child on their last preschool session of the week, and we ask that all bags are returned by the end of the following Tuesday.

We believe this initiative will strengthen the connection between home and school and support your child's learning journey in a fun and engaging way.

We are going to hold a stay and play session on **Wednesday 10th June at 2:00pm** to demonstrate and celebrate the launch of this new play library. Please see a member of the pre-school team to sign up.
