Wednesday 1st July **Information gathering**

We are inviting all new parents (up to 4 adults per family) and children to join in a picnic at the school. Families will need to bring their own picnic and seating/blankets.

When families have finished their picnic, we will invite families to walk through the school, passing their new classrooms.

When will my child start preschool?

Your child will be able to start their allocated sessions from Monday 14th September. Prior to your child starting Pre-school they will need to complete two settling-in sessions. From the 3rd – 4th of September, we will invite parents to join their child for a 1 hour settling-in session. From the 7-11th of September, we will invite children in for an independent settling-in session. **Please contact the school office to book your child's settling-in sessions.** On Monday 14th September we will confirm your child's class and teacher.
