Dear Parents,

I am excited to announce our new reading challenge that will run throughout Term 4 and 5. This reading challenge was popular last year therefore, we are anticipating high levels of engagement. As a school we encourage children to read regularly, and we have an exciting reward for those that do.

Throughout this term every time a child reads their school book they will earn a raffle ticket. Then, during celebration assembly each Friday, a name will be drawn from both Reception/KS1 and KS2 and the winning name will win an exciting book-themed prize bundle. Raffle tickets will remain in the jar for the whole term. Therefore, the more a child reads the more chance they will have of winning a book prize.

In order for your child's home reading to count towards winning the prizes; every read must be logged in their reading record. Learning Partners will begin filling in raffle tickets during their weekly book change on Friday 3rd March.

I will be sharing the new challenge with the children during assembly next week.

Finally, you continue to be welcomed into your child's class or the 'street' from 3:15pm until 3:30pm in Reception, Year 1 and 2 or 3:20pm until 3:35pm in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 Monday to Friday, to read your child's school books with them.
