## Welcome & Sign up meeting for all families

## Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 7:30pm – 8:30pm

- Meet the Principal/teaching team & share details of transition arrangements.
- Preparing for school.
- Receive information from school nursing team, Aspens Catering and uniform provider.
- To sign up for:
  - Stay & Play sessions.
  - Register interest for Breakfast Club.
  - Register interest for 'Parachutes' after school childcare.

## Pre-school/Nursery Information request:

### Week beginning Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> May

From this date, our SENCO, Mrs Lovely will contact nurseries to identify the special educational needs or disabilities (SEND) for children. The EYFS lead will also contact the settings for children not at Haywood Village Pre-School to arrange visits. If your child doesn't currently attend a preschool/nursery setting, the EYFS team may make a home visit to meet them.

#### <u>School visits – Stay & Play</u>

Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June 1:00 – 1:45pm or 2:00 – 2:45pm with parents.

Friday 30th June 1:00 – 1:45pm or 2:00 – 2:45pm without parents.

An invitation to all families, following sign up, to visit the school and enjoy two Stay & Play sessions in the reception classroom spaces. We hope your child can attend both sessions.

## Picnic Lunch

## Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July 11.00-12.00pm

We are inviting all new parents (up to 4 adults per family) to join us for a picnic on the school field, weather permitting. Families will need to bring their own picnic and blankets.

#### When will my child start school?

All reception children will be in school full time from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September. However, we have decided to arrange our transition days from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> September according to the age group of the children:

- Younger starters: April August born
- Older starters: September March born

- **SEND children:** The school will be made aware by nurseries/pre-schools of those pupils who have been identified as having special educational needs and/or disability (SEND).









# Friday 1st September and Monday 4th September – INSET days (no children in school)

### Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> – Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September

Younger starters & SEND children: mornings only 8:50am - 11:00am

Older starters: afternoons only 1:15pm – 3:15pm

It will be really important that parents adhere to their times to ensure a smooth transition for all children. Staff will be on the playground to support children and parents to find their classroom.

#### Monday 11<sup>th</sup> – Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> September

All children 8:50am - 12:00pm: everyday, mornings only

#### Friday 15<sup>th</sup> September

All children will stay for school lunch and go home afterwards: 8:50am – 1:30pm. The aim is to share your child's class and their teacher at the end of this day.

#### Monday 18<sup>th</sup> September

All children will be in school full time from this day, 8:50am – 3:15pm.
