Welcome & Sign up meeting for all families

Tuesday 21st May 7:30pm – 8:30pm

Pre-school/Nursery Information request:

Week beginning Monday 20th May

From this date, our SENCo, Mrs Lovely will contact nurseries to identify the special educational needs or disabilities (SEND) for children. A member of the EYFS team will also contact the settings for children not at Haywood Village Pre-School to arrange visits. If your child doesn't currently attend a pre-school/nursery setting, the EYFS team may make a home visit to meet them.

School visits – Stay & Play

Tuesday 2nd July 1:00 – 1:45pm or 2:00 – 2:45pm with parents.

Thursday 4th July 1:00 – 1:45pm or 2:00 – 2:45pm without parents.

An invitation to all families, following sign up, to visit the school and enjoy two Stay & Play sessions in the reception classroom spaces. We hope your child can attend both sessions.

Picnic Lunch

Friday 12th July 11.00-12.00pm

We are inviting all new parents (up to 4 adults per family) to join us for a picnic on the school field, weather permitting. Families will need to bring their own picnic and blankets.

When will my child start school?

All reception children will be in school full time from Monday 16th September. However, we have decided to arrange our transition days from Monday 2nd September according to the age group of the children:

- **Younger starters:** April – August born
- **Older starters:** September – March born
- **SEND children:** The school will be made aware by nurseries/pre-schools of those pupils who have been identified as having special educational needs and/or disability (SEND).

Please note Monday 2nd September and Tuesday 3rd September are INSET days and there will be no children in school.

Wednesday 4th – Friday 6th September

Older starters: [afternoons only](#) 1:15pm – 3:15pm

It will be really important that parents adhere to their times to ensure a smooth transition for all children. Staff will be on the playground to support children and parents to find their classroom.

Monday 9th – Thursday 12th September

All children 8:50am – 12:00pm: [everyday, mornings only](#)

Friday 13th September

All children will stay for school lunch and go home afterwards: 8:50am – 1:30pm.

The aim is to share your child's class and their teacher at the end of this day.

Monday 16th September

All children will be in school full time from this day, 8:50am – 3:15pm.
