Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to confirm the Year 6 residential to Beam House for Sunday 20th October to Wednesday 23rd October 2024. This will give the children an adventurous week time in a rural yet coastal location in Torrington, North-West Devon. The trip will be led and organised through PGL Travel Ltd, whilst accompanied by Haywood Village staff.

What's it all about?

It's about having fun whilst taking part in all sorts of adventurous activities designed to help your child learn and develop new skills and really shine as an individual and as part of a team.

For many children this may be their first experience of staying away from home without you. PGL staff and our own staff will be on hand throughout to encourage, reassure and help, so that your child returns home even more confident and independent with a real sense of achievement.

What does it cost?

The cost per child is £251.50 which can be paid in instalments prior to the trip. The cost includes:

- Return coach travel from school
- A full daily programme of adventure activities

- All meals, accommodation and bedding (dietary requirements will be accommodated)
- Full comprehensive travel insurance (details available on request or enclosed)

There are no extras costs. However, if you wish, you can provide a small amount of pocket money for your child to spend in the gift shop, we would limit this to £10.

What do I need to do next?

If you would like your child to go on the trip, please complete and return the form below. We usually ask for the deposit in December, however we are aware of the recent payments that have been requested for other school activities. With this in mind, we have decided to change the payment schedule slightly.

If you wish to pay more than this the system will allow you to do so. We just ask that the amount stated is the least amount you pay.

Please note that once deposits have been paid to PGL they are not refundable and terms and conditions will apply. The school has to pay the final invoice at the beginning of September 2024.
