Re: School trip to The Bristol Zoo Project- Thursday 28th March 2024

In Term 4 we will be learning about animals. We are focusing on identifying animals and exploring habitats. We will be visiting The Bristol Zoo project on Thursday 28th March 2024.

We will leave school at approximately 9.15am on a coach to go to The Bristol Zoo Project. During the visit we have an African Safari workshop and opportunity to see many of the animals around the park. We will be doing a lot of walking so, although full school uniform and sensible outdoor clothing is still essential, children are allowed to wear **sensible walking shoes/trainers**.

All children will be provided with a school packed lunch. We will return to school before the end of the day so children will still be able to attend clubs if they are part of any.

The cost of the trip covers the entire day including the workshop. The cost per child is £12.87 which needs to be paid via Scopay.
