**Re: Elm Class - Swimming lessons – Term 5**

We are pleased to confirm that we have been able to organise for your child to have regular swimming lessons in Term 5 for 4 weeks. The swimming lesson will take place on Monday mornings at Brean Splash with qualified swimming coaches starting on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2026. The lessons will take place over four weeks and each lesson will be for 1 hour. The dates for swimming will be:

- Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April
- Monday 27<sup>th</sup> April
- Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May
- Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May

The cost for the term will be **£18.50**, this will cover swimming lessons and transport. Payment will need to be made via the online payment system, MCAS, which is available now.

Please could the children wear their swimwear under their uniform to school. Please note – girls should wear full swimsuits and not bikinis. Please provide underwear for them to change into after the swim lessons.

Please complete the reply slip below to confirm your child's attendance, especially as they will be transported by coach. In addition, we are keen to know your child's confidence and competence in the swimming pool to enable the swimming teachers to provide the necessary support and challenge. Please note, we will communicate these lists of attainment with the Brean Splash and further reinforce our expectations that they use this assessment information from the first session.
