During the day, the children will explore life in the **Stone Age through to the Iron Age** using a range of engaging and hands-on activities. They will begin by learning about survival in the Stone Age, including a fun team challenge, before moving on to discover how life changed over time.

Throughout the day, the children will take part in activities such as a **Stone Age quiz, artefact handling**, and exploring how early people lived and worked together. In the afternoon, they will focus on later periods, including working as a team to recreate the building of **Stonehenge** and learning about Bronze and Iron Age life.

The day will finish with a reflection on everything they have learned.
